- **4.** Tell others in the Colony what you have discovered.

#### 2. Communicator Activity Badge

In order to achieve this award you will need to do several things:

- 4. Spell your name in Morse code, semaphore, the phonetic alphabet, or using pictures and symbols.
- **5.** Try to work out a simple message given to you in Morse code, semaphore, the phonetic alphabet, or using pictures and symbols.

Numbers 1 – 3 you will be able to complete with help from your leader.

During your visit to our radio station we will help you complete the numbers 4 and 5.





- Go to a District fun day and talk to some other Beavers you don't know.
- Try all of the food on Beaver sleepover.
- Remember to feed your pet every morning for a week.

Now that you have finished exploring the radio station, it can be fun to send a message to another Scout by radio. This will also be part of your Personal Challenge Award. One of the operators will help you to write your message and send it.
